This Summer, the Armenian Director of Veteran Affairs pleaded with Sister Veronica to take in around 50 WWII Veterans who were suffering unbearable living conditions because of the heat wave that covered most of Eastern Europe and the Middle East. They had no where to take them. When she went to visit the Veterans she found some of them suffering from starvation, covered in lice, living in horrible conditions like the picture upper left. Because of a donation we were able to bring in 8 of them to the House of Hope for the Summer. Without sponsors, they will have to go back to their miserable living conditions. This would be a tragedy . These men (and some women) were our allies in WWII, and are in the final years of their lives. Most don't know Christ, but Sister Veronica will surely lead them to the Savior! We need a miracle for Sponsors, so they can remain at the House of Hope.

For those who saw the sad pictures in our last News Letter, this lady to the left will be familiar. This is Sister Star, whom we visited on our last trip to Armenia. She was living in an old metal container and was suffering from the effects of a stroke. Now she has a sponsor and... well the happy face tells it all!



These Elderly WWII Veterans have been bathed, and given clean clothes that was sent over in the last container from F.G.I.D.C. It is hard to imagine that just days before, they were unwashed, and their clothes were old and dirty, and suffering in the unbearable heat. Now when they are told about Jesus, it will be more than just words! They will know the Love of God is real, for they are experiencing it thru God's people.
