Rosa Chaxoyan was born on September 10, 1925. She is from the city of Spitak, Armenia, where the catastrophic earthquake struck in 1988. Some estimate the death total for Armenia was around one hundred thousand. Since her home was destroyed, she lived in this container box similar to what they ship stuff in on railroad cars. In the middle photo, you can see some of the horrible living conditions and what few possessions she had. She doesn't have any children of her own. In the note I received about her it said, "Now she is all by herself and she has nobody who can bury her when she dies." Remember God hears the cry of the poor and forsaken of this world and He heard Rosa's prayer and sent her to the House of Hope to be clothed, fed, loved, told about Jesus and His saving grace and someone to take care of her even when she dies. Because of your giving and support, another person in their 80's will be saved!



Here is the testimony sent by Sister Veronica of Akassi Kocharyan, born in 1924. His relatives brought and left him in the House of Hope and never even came back to know how he is doing. When he came he was so hungry. He told us that his relatives would not feed him enough so he wouldn't go to the toilet, since nobody wanted to clean him up after going. His kids left for Europe for a better living and left their father without help and hope.

ASIA: River of Life International has supported various projects over the years in Asia. One of these is a Bible School that trains mostly believers from minority groups or the "Tribal People". They come from remote villages where there may be only a handful of Christians, and where most of the people have never heard of Jesus. Our friend and missionary to this area, recently traveled nine hours and most of it on bumpy roads to one of these villages. He found a group of believers there among these tribal people whose village is so remote.

This ministry supports the School among other projects. We recently made contact with a pastor over a large church that was starting a Bible School with mostly college students. He wanted the School of Christ material in their language for his students, which was provided by Brother B.H. Clendennen within Asia.

We have an ongoing project of getting a new believers training manual translated. This was provided by the F.G. I. Church in CT. This will be a blessing to the new Christians in Asia who know virtually nothing about the Bible or their new found faith in Jesus.
