ASIA

The Lord wonderfully directed our steps during our recent trip to Asia. I arrived just in time to teach at a secret Bible training school, before the students were to go out for weeks of village evangelism. They would be living with the tribal people and sharing Christ with many who have never heard His wonderful name. Most of the students were very young, and it blessed me to see their dedication, as the possibility of arrest and imprisonment can be a reality for them. As I taught the word of God, I encouraged them to be filled with the Holy Ghost and then laid hands on them and prayed for the Spirit of God to anoint them as they went out into the villages to preach the gospel.

I was able to carry in a special Bible training program for new believers that was put together by the F.G.I. Church in Connecticut. This is now being translated and will then be printed into booklets that can be passed out to newborn Christians who have no knowledge of the Bible or the Christian faith. It is much needed and will be a great training tool for new believers.

I then traveled to another part of Asia to meet with Church leaders who are ministering to large congregations and who also need training materials for the many college age believers who are in their churches. We are now working to get them the School of Christ materials for their secret Bible School. An estimated twenty five thousand people per day are coming to Christ in this atheist country. God is moving mightily, and especially among young people. Please pray for the believers there and those who risk their lives and freedom to labor among them.

We deeply appreciate anyone who feels led of the Lord to help us with the expense of traveling back to Asia to preach the Gospel and train leaders.

TESTIMONY FROM SISTER VERONICA

They recently showed an elderly lady on the news that had escaped from a Government nursing home. She had walked so far and then fell exhausted on the street, where someone found her and sent her to the hospital in Gyumri. The head Doctor of that hospital called journalists to interview her. She told that she is 80 years old and that she escaped from the Government home since the conditions there are so bad and she was treated so terrible. Now she has no place to go and that she was going to meet Christmas in the streets. When I heard this interview, I hurried to get the address of the hospital and sent someone to bring her to the House of Hope. Now she is in the House of Hope. She is fed, washed and in a warm bed. When the Doctor heard about the House of Hope he wants to send journalists to interview and show about our ministry of love and care by T V all over Armenia.

NEEDS FOR THE HOUSE OF HOPE

Since the water shortage, we have to buy water from the Fire Dept and store it in tanks. We can dig and put in a well for \$3100.00 which is desperately needed.

The winters are treacherous and the roads sometimes impassable. We need around \$ 25,000.00 to pay off the late model 4x4 SUV we will ship over. Please pray and let God speak to your heart about helping.

Dear people of God, I want to thank you all for supporting my ministry and becoming a part of the evangelism I have started among elderly.

If not for your support and prayers I wouldn't be able to reach those who are miserable, lonely elderly for Christ. You and me are given an opportunity to use the last chance to reach souls of dying elderly.

Through your help we have managed to equip the building with special adjustable beds, wheel-chairs, walkers and other necessary items you have enclosed in 13 ton container you sent for the House of hope. The clothing you sent is a great help since most of the elderly who come don't have clothes to wear.

Thanks for installing new fire, and water sprinkler system in the building. You helped us to preserve 70 cans of vegetable stew and fruit jams

The Whole city talks about the love of God they see in the House of Hope and bakery that feeds 150 people through your support. The mayor of the city of Vanadzor, has just finished rebuilding the road to the house of hope which was remaining ruined from Soviet times.

The Lord has blessed us with an anointed staff and we are like one mind and heart in this vision.

Right now we are having 45 elderly who are adopted by you. They are not orphans any more. Since we are opened ,11 elderly passed away .They met Christ in the House of Hope before they left this world. This is what my vision is about.

God has privileged us to establish works that are a testimony to others. These works will show a true, risen living Christ not a humanitarian organization.

I have a word from the Lord, that any home I visit any door I knock, His love is going to flow and touch their hearts and make a way for Himself.

The Lord gave me a new strategy for evangelism

- 1.To have a hot line for rescuing elderly (like 911 in USA)
2. To have van that can rush to the destination address
- 3.To have equipped volunteers for this task

I am ready to go to other regions and even countries for home visits and evangelism, if only God and You send me
